Jen:	The barman says to the horse "Why the long face?"
Helen:	Why would a horse be in a bar?
Jen:	It doesn't matter – it's a joke. It's a <i>horse</i> so the barman says "Why the long face?"
Helen:	我还是没听懂这个笑话。
Jen:	Well, the horse has a long face.
Helen:	So it's unhappy?
Jen:	No, well, yes, but that's the joke. Horses have long faces.
Helen:	So why did it go into the bar again?
